
RESTRICTIONS IN ACCESS

" (...) since the 1980s, the authorities increasingly protected monuments by keeping "them under lock and key", said conservation and cultural heritage expert Omniya Abdel Barr.








AR 3D - URBAN MEMORY AND FUTURE

Various 3D AR trials using local architecture as a point of departure for a dialogue of forms and imagining different art experiences in public space.




